**5** = student who participated in a variety of activities during the course of four years of high school, and took on leadership responsibilities in at least some of those activities.

**1** = student rarely participated in any community activity.

**3** = student has been involved in community activities, but these were limited and not over the four years of high school.

**5** = student participated in a variety of community activities during the course of four years of high school.

### **Academic achievement:** \_\_\_\_\_ **points**

**(Include GPA, Class Rank and ACT/SAT score(s) in point consideration.)**

**1** = student who did not pursue academically challenging course work.

**3** = student who took some harder courses but got by on natural ability more than effort and persistence. Consider GPA, Class Rank and ACT/SAT score(s).

**5** = student who took challenging courses based on his or her abilities and goals and performed well at those higher challenges.

### **Financial:** \_\_\_\_\_ **points**

**1** = level of financial hardship is not evident.

**3** = level of financial hardship is evident in one or more areas: scholarships received, other dependents, and/or family hardship conditions.

**5** = level of financial hardship is very evident in the areas of scholarships not received, other dependents, and/or family hardships.
